Objective

- Seeking approval for:
 - Revised wholesale Pilot Program Demand Response Resource (Special Power Product No. 11) Rate Schedule
 - Revised retail Pilot Program Demand Response Resource Rider (DRR-Rider) Rate Schedule

Background

- Current wholesale provisions allow for NPPD to retain 20% of SPP market net revenues (per customer) or a minimum of \$900/week when customer participates in the market
 - Current retail provisions include a \$900/week Administration Charge and provide for the participating customer to receive 75% of SPP market net revenues (if positive)
- Minimum floor of \$900/week is a concern for small customers and appears to be a hurdle for them to be successful under this rate

Proposed Revisions

- Wholesale Pilot Program DRR (Special Power Product No. 11) Rate Schedule
 - Eliminate the \$900/week minimum floor
- Retail Pilot Program DRR-Rider Rate Schedule
 - Reduce the \$900/week Administrative Charge to \$50/week

Schedule

- October 23 – Issued proposed revised wholesale DRR Rate Schedule to wholesale customers
- November 22 – Hearing requests due (none received)
- December 14 – Board consideration of proposed wholesale and retail DRR Rate Schedules
- January 1, 2024 – Proposed effective date
