## **2023 Legislative Overview**

- First Session of the 108<sup>th</sup> Legislature
  - January 4 to June 1, Legislative Day 88
  - 17 New Senators
  - New Clerk of the Legislature
  - New Governor's Policy Research Office Director
  - New Speaker, Presiding Officer, New Committee Chairs
  - 820 Bills Introduced
  - 107 Priority Bills
  - Confirmation Reports

## **2023 Legislative Summary**

- 31 Bills Passed/Signed
  - Numerous Committee packages
  - 291 Total bills including package amendments
  - 72/107 Priority Bills including package amendments
  - 24/31 Bills received 40 or more votes for passage
- Budget Bills
  - LB 814 Perkins County Canal spending authority
  - LB 818 Perkins County Canal funding \$574 million

#### **Bills of Interest**

- LB 565 Hydrogen Hub grant for engineering and modeling
  - \$250,000 for each FY 23-24 and 24-25
  - High level managers of a PPD may serve on the board of another PPD (LB 567)
  - Definition of "Reliability" (LB 567)
  - Clarifies requirements for the annual Load and Capability Report to the Power Review Board (LB 567)
  - Adopts the Nuclear and Hydrogen Development Act (LB 568)
    - \$200,000 to a fund which terminates on July 31, 2028
  - Authorizes NDNR to use Design-Build on certain projects (LB 723)

#### **Bills of Interest**

- LB 683 Creates the Nebraska Broadband Office
  - Moves some broadband authority to the Dept. of Transportation including federal funding
  - Withholds NUSF allocations for services and equipment which are a threat to national security (LB 63)
  - Creates the Underground Excavation Safety Committee (LB 122)
    - Moves some authority (penalties up to \$10,000) from the Attorney General to the State Fire Marshall
    - Membership: Fire Marshall; three Operators; three Excavators
    - Operational date of September 1, 2024

#### **2023 Interim Studies**

- LR178 (Brewer) Executive Board Interim study to examine the feasibility of constructing and operating small modular nuclear reactors to generate electric power in Nebraska
- LR216 (Dungan) Natural Resources Interim study to examine the economic and climate impacts of the current reliance on fossil fuel energy generation in Nebraska
- LR242 (Jacobson) Revenue Interim study to examine methods to promote the development of a competitive electric vehicle charging market in Nebraska and the creation of electric infrastructure to support such market

#### **2023 Interim Studies**

- LR247 (Cavanaugh, J.) GMVA Interim study to examine issues raised in LB133, 2023, relating to laws regarding the use of eminent domain by state agencies, boards, commissions, and other political subdivisions
- LR248 (Cavanaugh, J.) Natural Resources Interim study to survey Nebraska's small public utilities, municipalities, and cooperatives in a comprehensive manner, which consolidates information relating to rate classifications and equipment

### **2024 Legislative Preview**

- 108<sup>th</sup> Legislature Second Session
  - 60 Legislative Days
  - Leadership positions serve the second of a two-year term
  - No change in rules unless voted upon
  - First Session bills can carry over
  - Statewide election dates
    - May 14 Primary
    - November 5 General Election
