




## **Professional Retail Operations Agreement**

- > 79 PRO Contract Communities
- > 15-25 Year Term Agreements
  - Extension PRO Agreement: 15-25 Year with Wholesale Power Requirement
  - Enhanced PRO Agreement: 25 Year Retail
- Community owns the Distribution System
  - NPPD operates the Distribution System as part of our Statewide Integrated Electric Utility System

#### Lease Payment

- NPPD Collects and Remits Lease Payment equal to 12% of Adjusted Retail Revenues
  - Enhanced PRO offers flexibility to adjust LP 0.5% per year by Council Approval
  - ➤ Enhanced PRO Lease Payment Cap of 14%
- NPPD Collects and Remits 5% Gross Revenue Tax and City Sales Tax as applicable

## **Professional Retail Operations Agreement**

- NPPD Operates PRO Communities as part of Integrated Utility Electric System
  - > NPPD Board sets rates and policies regarding electric service
  - NPPD renders bills, operates system, provides customers service, handles customer inquiries, responds to outages, etc.
- > NPPD assumes all Operational and Financial responsibility and risk
  - Capital Additions / Maintenance / Repairs / Replacements
  - Emergent / Storm Events


### **Professional Retail Operations Agreement**

- Municipal Discount
  - > Tax-Supported Entities (>50%) Receive 33-1/3% Discount
    - > Municipal Services, School Districts, Counties
  - Excluded from Lease Payment
    - Enhanced PRO offers Lease Payment option for Municipal Discount Customers
- Renewable Generation
  - ➤ All Retail Communities have option to install Renewable Generation up to 10% of their Peak Demand under Qualifying Local Generation (QLG)
  - > ~24MW Community Solar

#### **Operations and Maintenance Agreement (O&M)**

- > 9 O&M Agreement Communities
  - ➤ Term is typically 10 20 Years
- Community owns the Distribution System
- Community Hires NPPD to design, operate and maintain the Distribution System on a time/material basis
- > Community sets rates, renders bills, and handles customer service
- Community approves all capital spend and has all financial responsibility and risk for the electric system


#### NPPD Retail EIA Percentile Rank
