Current Plant Status

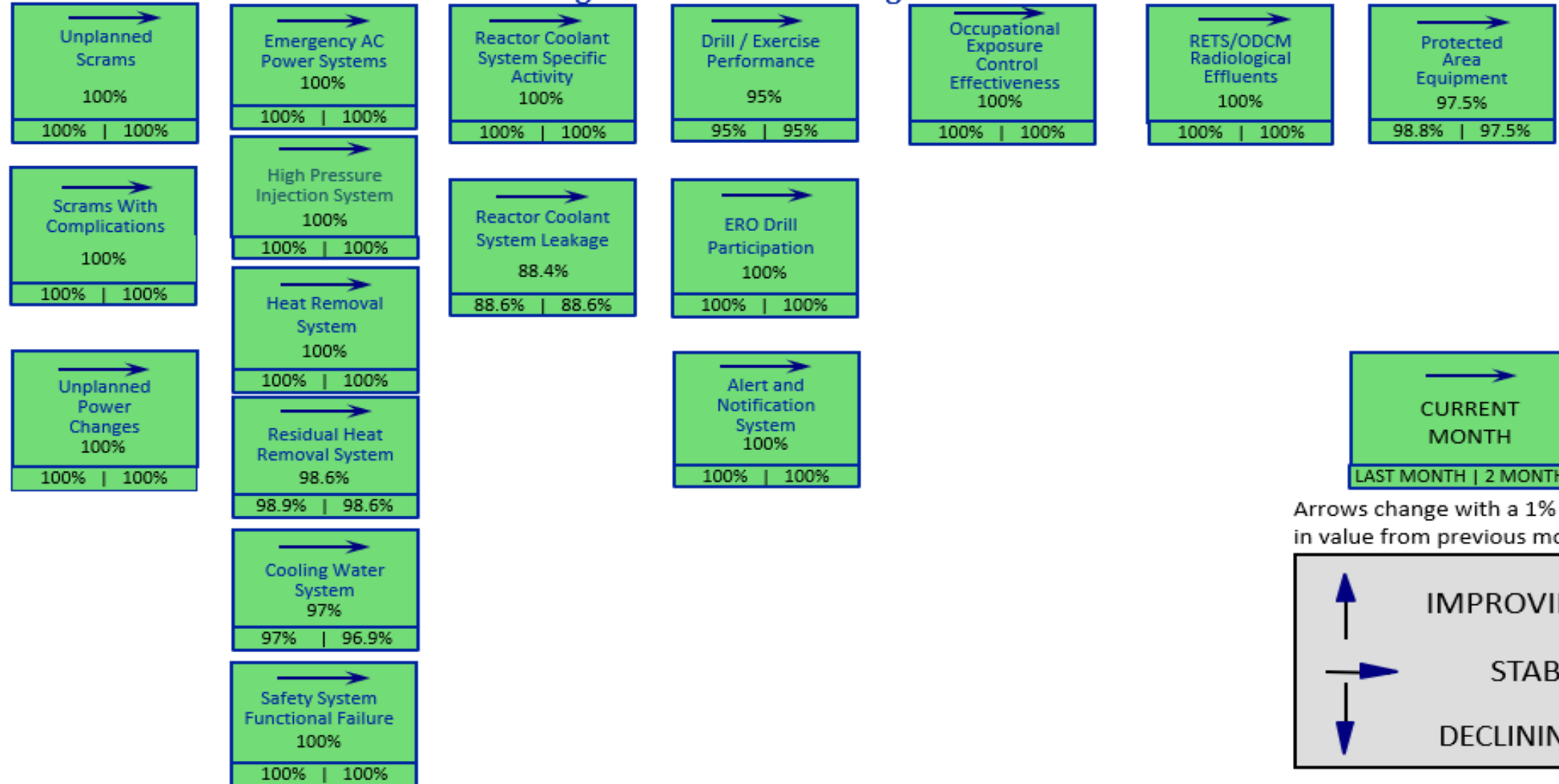
- 92 Day Injury-Free

- Level III Violation- related to licensed operator medical condition status change without notifying the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (no safety concern)
- NRC completed their evaluation last week after we finish our root cause evaluation and concluded that the violation will be Traditional Enforcement Severity Level III with no Civil Penalty and no follow up actions (great news).
