2025 Legislative Session

Natural Resources Committee:

- Tom Brandt (Chairman) (Vice Chair selection has not been held)
- Stanley Clouse

- Proposed Rule Change 23
 - Remove the Natural Resources Committee and replace with the Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee
 - Operative on January 6, 2027 if approved

2025 Legislative Session

New for 2025:

- Rule 5-4d
 - Senators may introduce up to 20 bills
 - Committees may introduce up to 10 bills including interim study bills
 - Bills introduced at the request of the Governor are not included in the limit
- Video Archives (LB 254 passed in 2023)
 - Archived video of floor debate
 - Archived video of hearings
 - Accessed through the daily calendar on the legislature website

2025 Legislation:

- 258 new bills (through day 5)
- 7 Proposed Constitutional Amendments (through day 5)
- NPPD reviewing bills of interest
