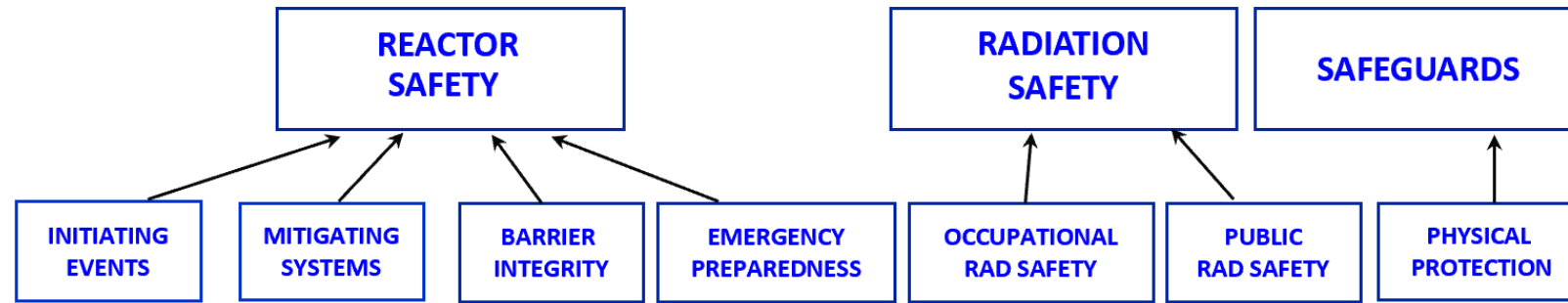
Current Plant Status

 - Budgeted - 2,215,885

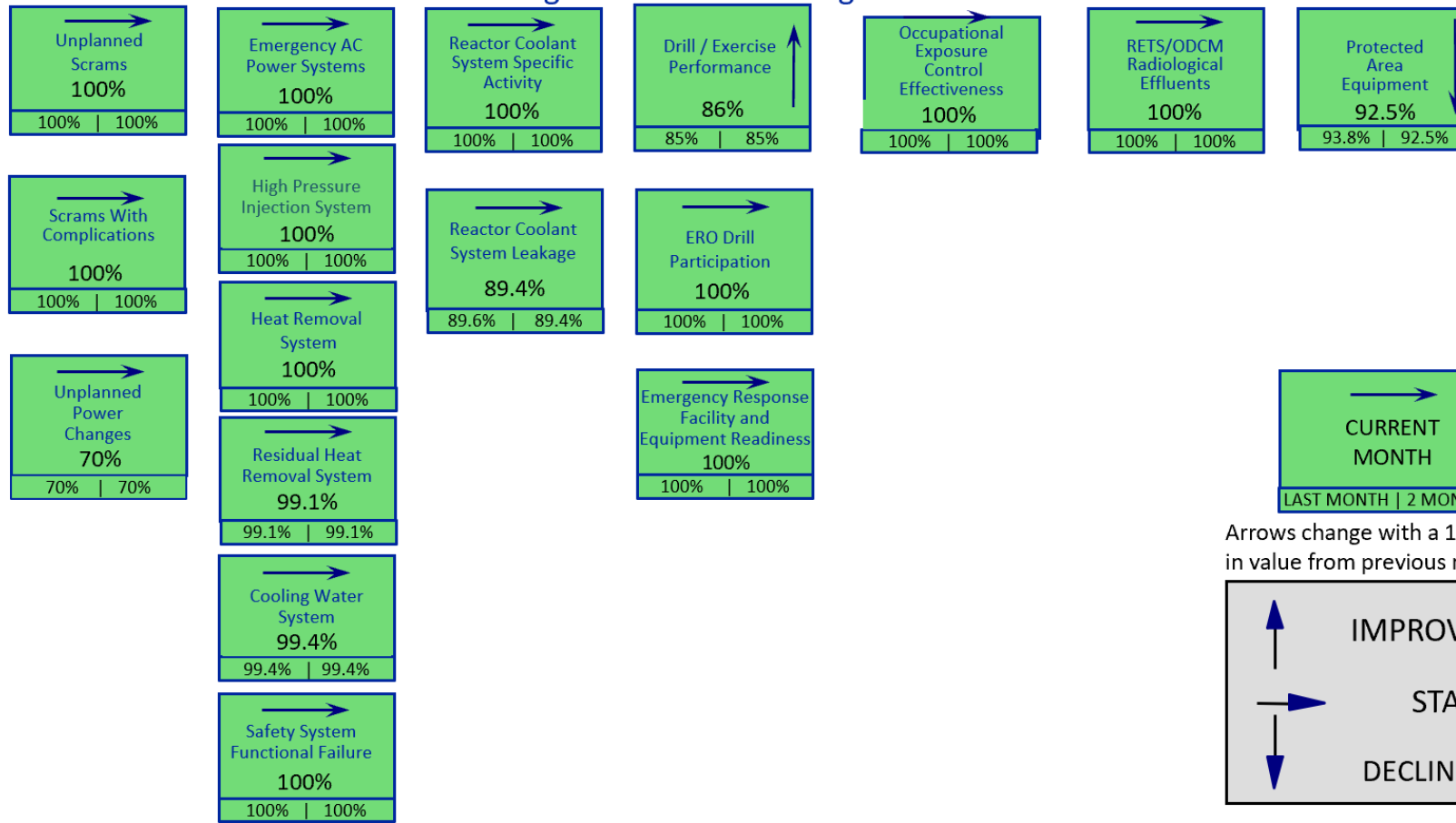
Current Regulatory Status
