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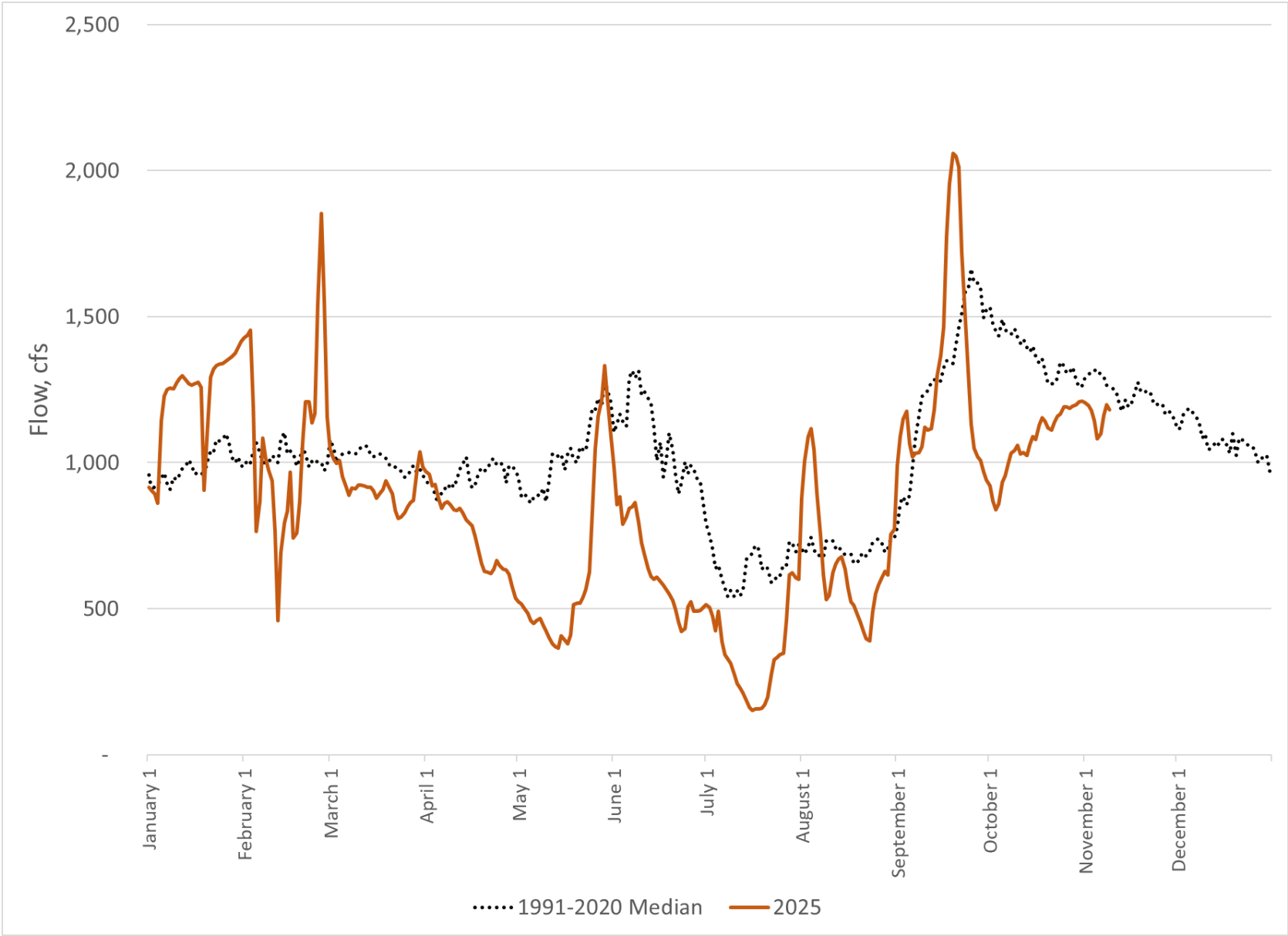

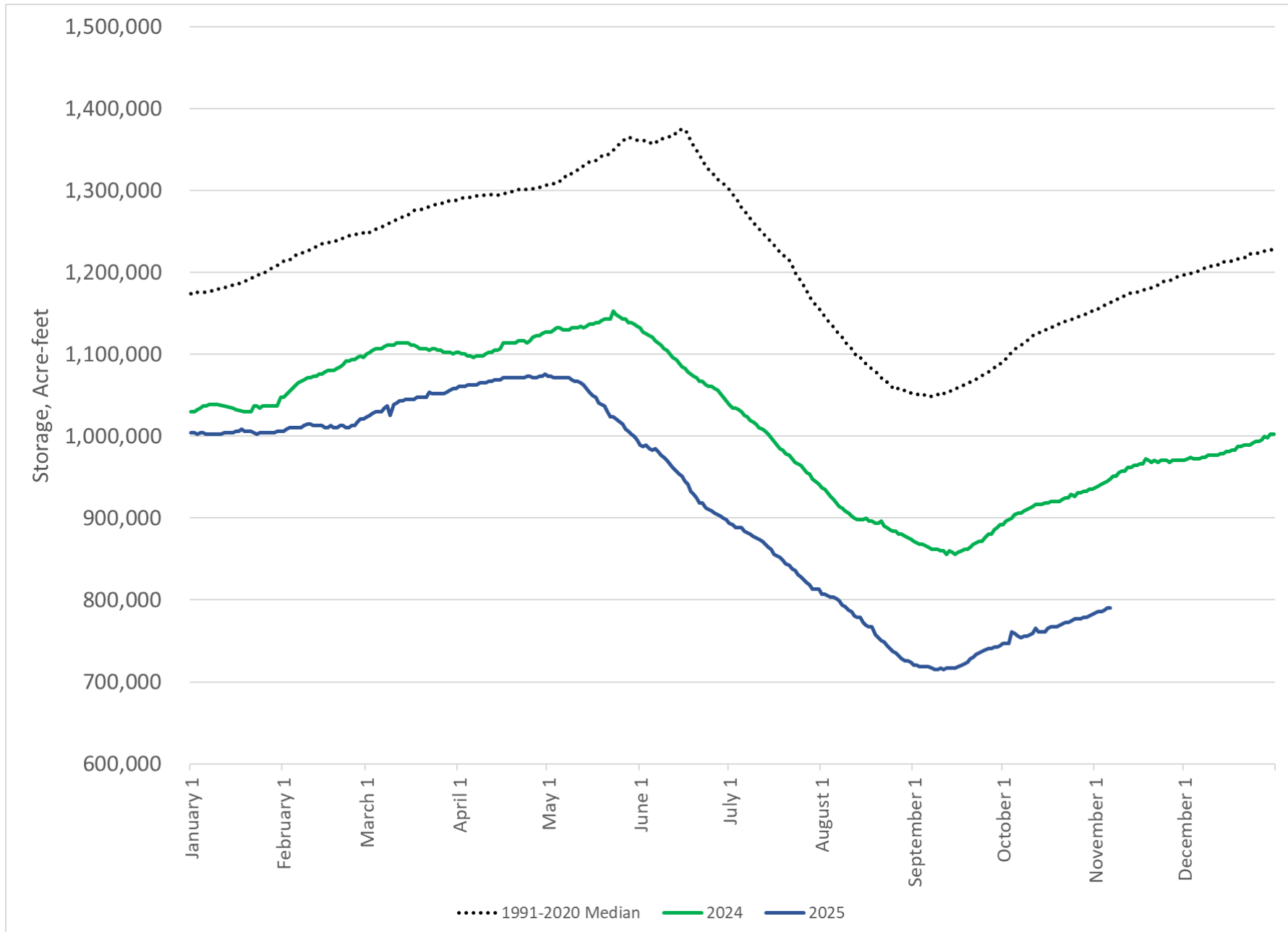
# Lake McConaughy Inflows (North Platte River at Lewellen)

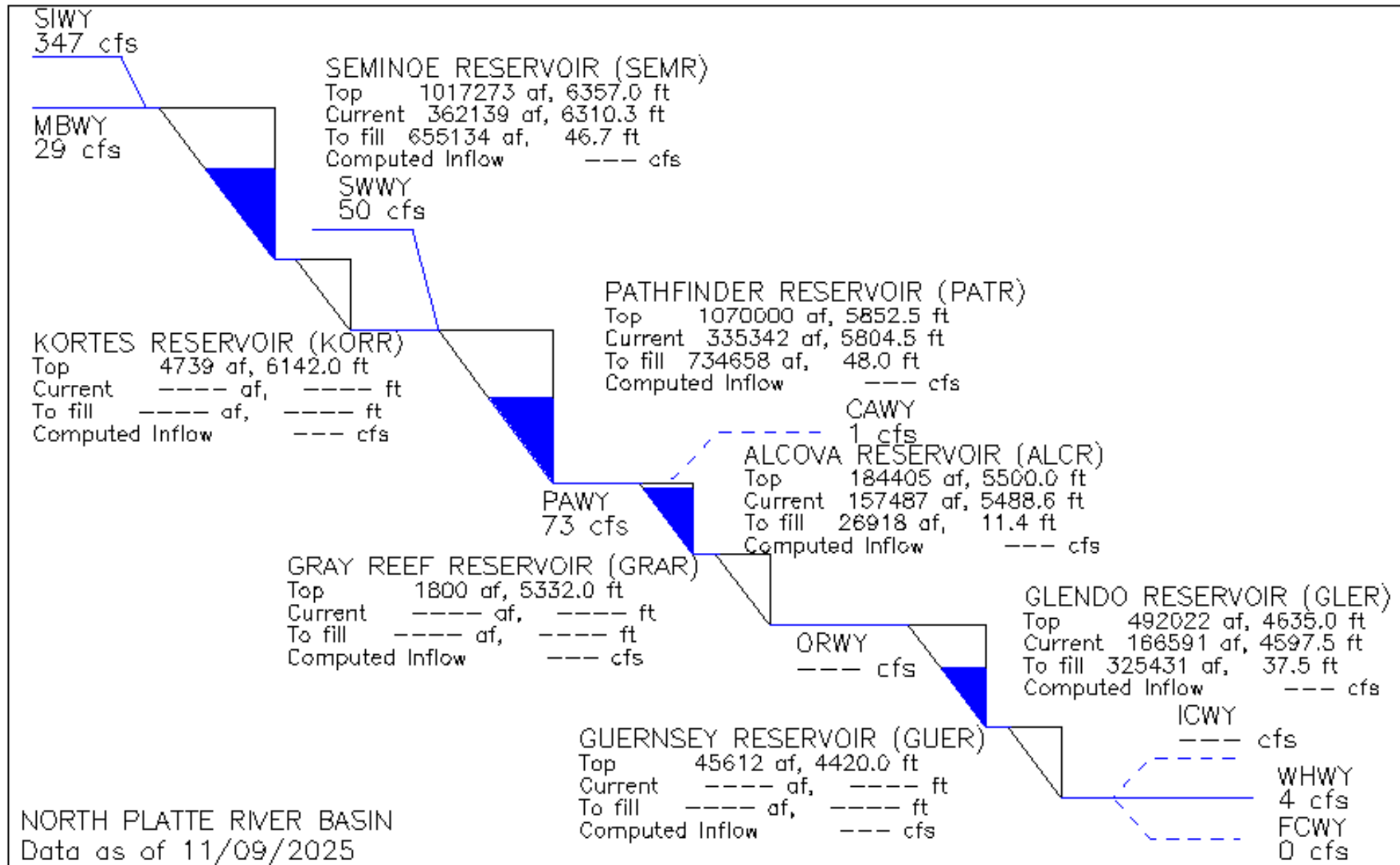


# Lake McConaughy Storage

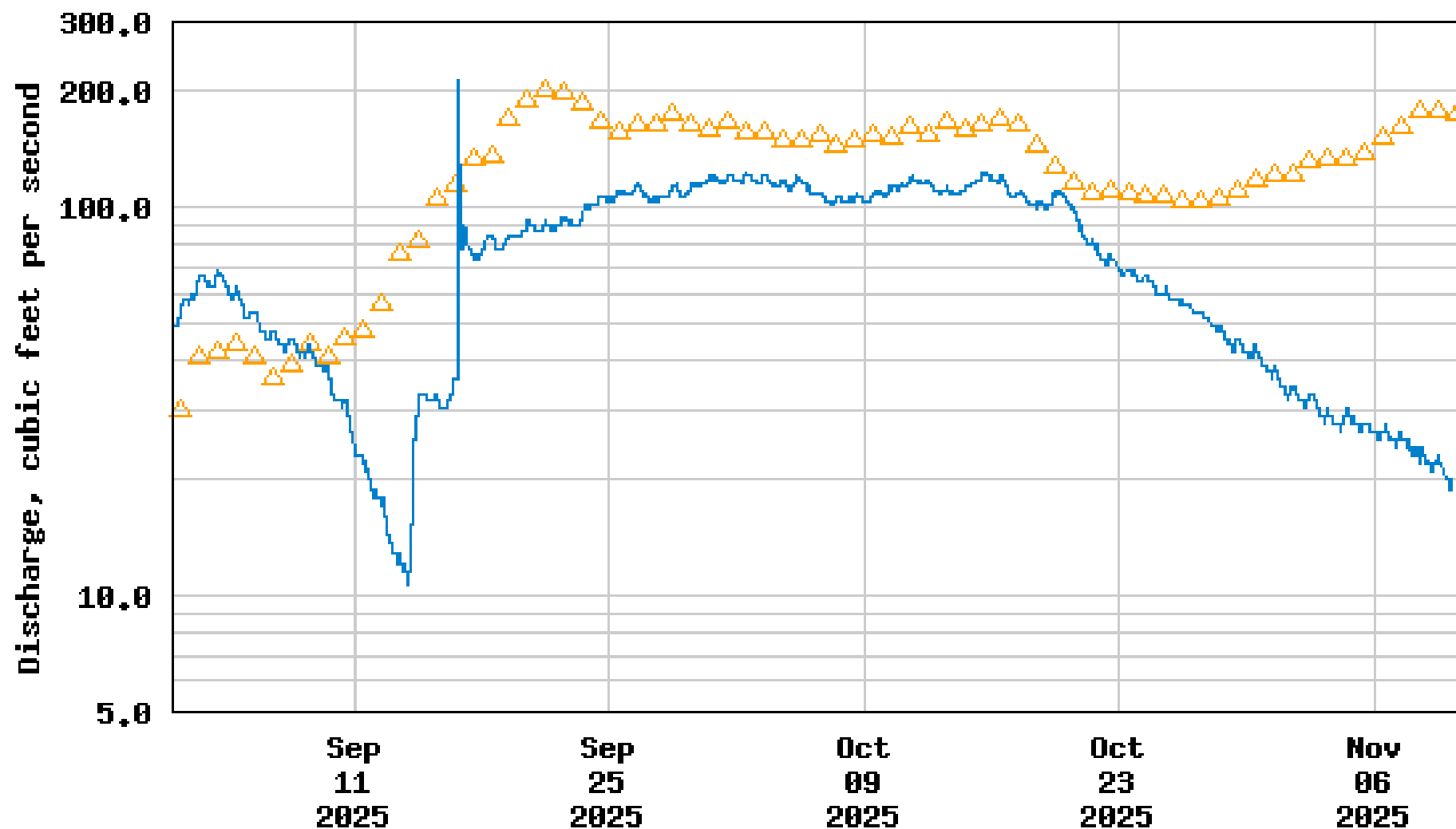

# Wyoming Reservoir Storage

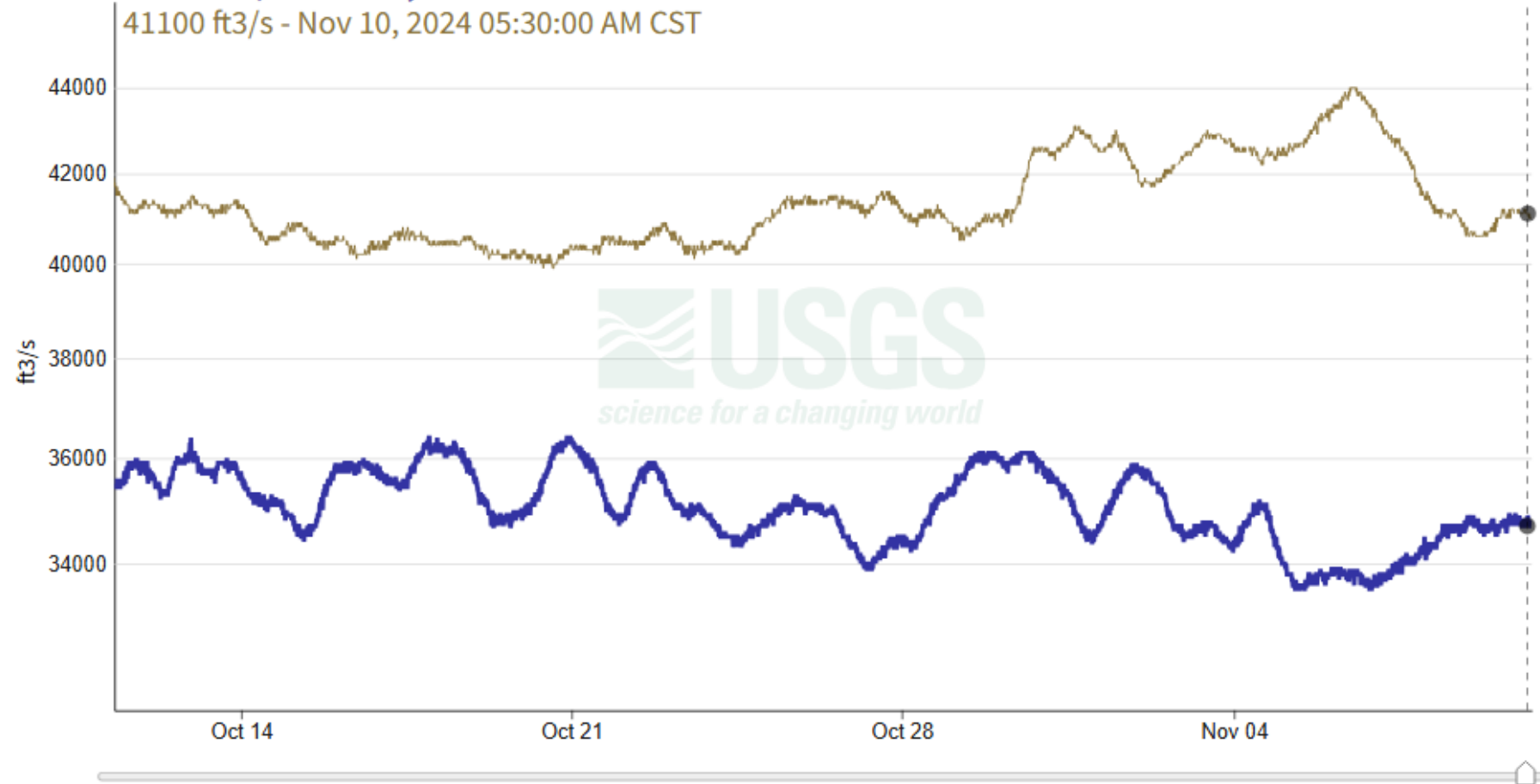

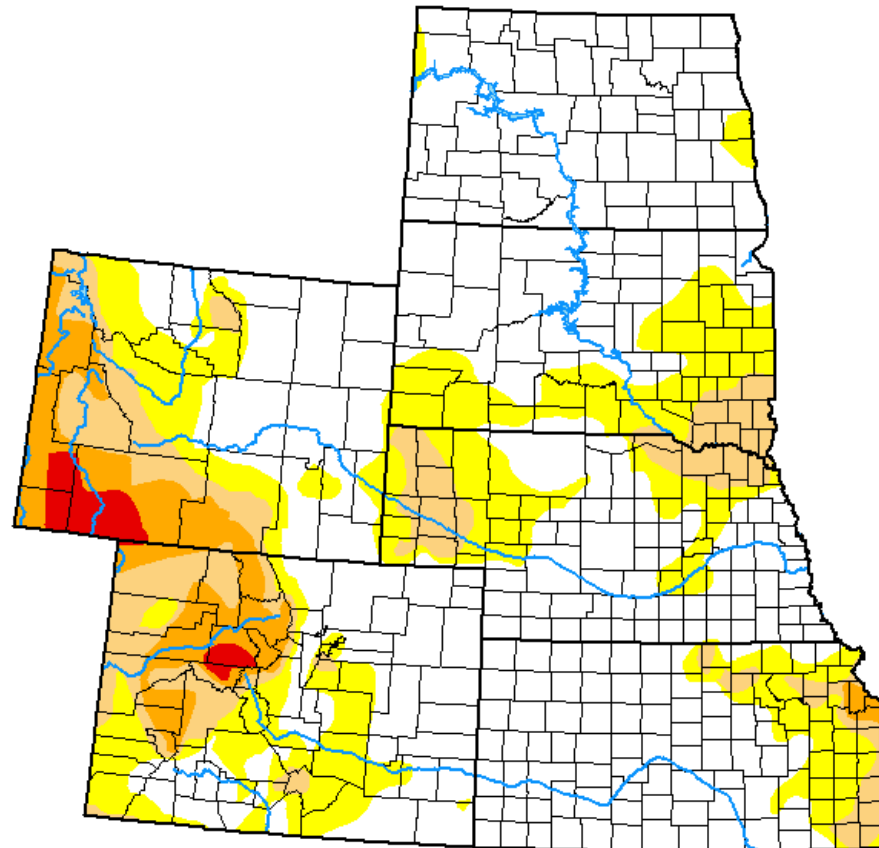

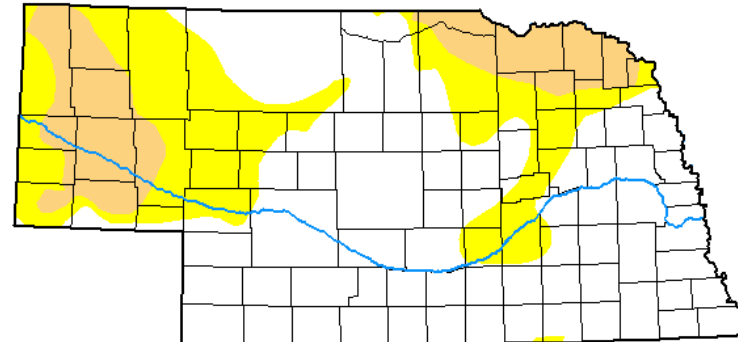
