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Scope

- Provide craft and administrative personnel for work at Production facilities (excluding CNS).
- Supplemental labor cost-effectively augments the District's workforce during periods of peak labor demand.
- Craft labor support can be adjusted to meet changing needs without affecting District staffing.
- Two-year term January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2027.

Bid Evaluation

- **The bids from MOR PPM, Inc. and DZ Atlantic were evaluated using matrix evaluation scoring.**
 - ✓ Price (25% weight). Both bids were nearly identical and scored the same.
 - ✓ MOR PPM had the best total score and best scores for:
 - Fossil Plant Experience (25% weight)
 - Program/Wage Rates (20%)
 - References (20%)
 - Safety performance (10%)

Recommendation

Accept the estimated base bid price of \$31,994,345.48, submitted by MOR PPM, Inc., as the lowest and best evaluated bid on Contract No. 25-017.
