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Background

- Three (3) Power Transformers needed for the Princeton Road Station Phase 2 Project.
- Resolution No. 25-9 authorized management to enter into competitive negotiations for three 345 kV/19.5 kV 350 MVA generator step-up transformers.
- District personnel issued a Request for Bid (RFB) for said transformers and received seven (7) bids.
 - The RFB allowed the bidders to provide firm pricing or pricing subject to escalation.

¹Cost for current tariff charges were inadvertently included with the Base Bid, resulting in a reduction of \$4,271,439.

Other adjustment was for losses during 20 years of operation.



Bid Summary (cont'd)

- Six of the seven bidders did not meet the minimum experience requirements.
- WEG Transformers USA, bid meets the minimum experience requirements, the required delivery and in-service dates (May/June 2031), and were the best and lowest total evaluated base bid price.

Recommendation

Authorize management to execute contract 26-009, for the three power transformers, to WEG Transformers USA, at an estimated price of \$25,019,757 which includes performance bond costs.
